PSEUDICYEMA TRUNCATUM Whitman [*Hyman*, 1940, p. 235, fig. 68] Infecting the kidney of *Sepia officinalis*, often heavily, observed regularly 1949-57 (March-April); no adult Sepia free from infection has yet been seen (G.M.S.)

Order ORTHONECTIDA

RHOPALURA GRANOSA Atkins, 1933a, p. 233

In Heteranomia squamula from Lepralia foliacea in the aquarium Nov. 1932, and from Revelstoke and Stoke Points, Feb. 1933 (D.A.)

Breeding: larvae seen Nov. and Feb. (D.A.)
